

- □ Completed commercial permit application.
- Owner's affidavit, with owner's signature notarized, designating a licensed pool <u>or General</u> contractor as the agent.
- □ Two (2) sets of signed and sealed Engineered drawings, indicating compliance with the Florida Building Code 5<sup>th</sup> Edition, Section 424.
- Plans shall provide accessibility in accordance with Section 242 of the Florida Accessibility Code 5<sup>th</sup> Edition
- □ Plans should include a piping diagram of the pool, including;
  - Information as to the protection of the potable water system, such as backflow preventers
  - Details of the pool waste discharge system.
    Please note: Discharge may not be to sanitary sewer system.
- □ Provide Electrical plans and address the following:
  - Show location of pool pumps and appurtenant equipment.
  - Show location of any panel or subpanel supplying pool equipment.
  - Provide load calculation of all pool equipment (pumps, lights, heaters, etc.)
  - Indicate breaker and wire sizes for branch and feeder circuits.
- □ If gas heaters are used, the following shall be addressed:
  - Indicate if system is a 2 lb. or ½ lb. system.
  - Provide gas piping diagram, with all calculations, that indicates all of the following:
    - Location of gas meter,
    - Demand values for all gas-fired appliances,
    - Pipe sizes, and
    - Distance of longest run
- □ Two (2) copies of the approved site plan. Plan shall show the location of the fence around the pool, and indicate the name of the fence installer.
- □ Solar Heating Separate permits are required for any photovoltaic or thermal solar systems. Contact 891-7001, option 2 for further information regarding solar permit applications.
